The following Affidavit is submitted to the Court to document the probable cause in support of a request for the issuance of an Arrest Warrant for **Shane Hugh Reed, DOB: 11/02/1991, AGE: 30, SSN:**

This offense is fully documented in Colorado Springs Police Department Report 22-9656 detailing the offense(s) of:

- §18-3-302 (1), SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING, CLASS FOUR FELONY (F4)
- §18-6-401 (1)(A)(7)(A), CHILD ABUSE-KNOWINGLY/RECKLESSLY ANY INJURY OTHER THAN SBI, CLASS ONE MISDEMEANOR (M1)
- §18-3-206, MENACING -THREAT/PHYSICAL ACTION/FEAR OF SBI, CLASS THREE MISDEMEANOR, (M3)
- §18-9-111 (1)(A), HARRASSMENT-STRIKE,SHOVE,KICK, CLASS THREE MISDEMEANOR (M3)

Your Affiant, Detective Donya Davis/1396D is currently assigned to the Crimes Against Children's Unit and has 26 years of law enforcement experience. Your Affiant is responsible for conducting felony investigations involving the abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, and homicide of children.

The information contained in this Affidavit was compiled by your Affiant during the course of an official criminal investigation, by speaking with fellow law enforcement officers, by speaking with witnesses, by reviewing official law enforcement reports and by your Affiant's own observations.

The facts contained within this Affidavit are fully documented in an official CSPD case report identified as 2022-9656.

Your Affiant states under oath she has personal knowledge of the following facts:

On Wednesday 03/09/2022 at approximately 05:30 hours, your Affiant arrived at the office and noted a voicemail from                      DOB:01/13/1965, father of                      DOB: 01/24/2007. Your Affiant is aware that Shane Hugh Reed DOB: 11/02/1991 is a Violation of Protection Order.

Your Affiant noted the following information in the voicemail:

                     stated he needed to report an incident his son,                      had told him yesterday (03/08/2022) evening. He said                      said Shane had assaulted him and threatened to kill him.                      said he thought this incident might have occurred on or about January 30th.                      said friend                      witnessed this incident and was at his house and talked about the incident.                      said                      said he couldn't hear what Shane was saying to                      but saw, how Shane dragged                      across the green way and pushed him against a residential fence.

On 03/09/2022 your Affiant contacted [redacted] and arranged for a forensic interview of [redacted] at 09:00 hours at Safe Passage. Investigative Specialist (IS) Lauren MoFarlin/6343C was familiar with the related investigations and with [redacted] and was assigned to conduct the forensic interview.

Your Affiant noted that Investigative Specialist (IS) Nikki Patton/4093C was assigned to conduct the interview with [redacted] friend [redacted] DOB: 11/20/2008.

Your Affiant observed both [redacted] and [redacted] interviews and noted the following:

[redacted] reported he told his father last night (03/08/2022) about the incident with Shane. He said he was with his friend [redacted]. He said they were on their bikes in the neighborhood where [redacted] lives. Your Affiant learned [redacted] lives at [redacted] described that approximately across the street from [redacted] house there is a "passageway" that leads to a greenbelt in the neighborhood. He described that it was early evening, like dusk.

[redacted] reported he saw a grayish-black truck, maybe a Chevy Silverado 2015 model, with temporary plates that stopped with the headlights shining on him and [redacted]. He said he saw Shane got out of the truck. He said he knew Shane is [redacted]

He reported Shane wore a baseball cap as he frequently does, but also had a "police belt" on. He said he knew it was a Police belt because it had all the pouches on it. [redacted] described he saw a circular pouch but denied seeing a weapon or any content of those pouches.

[redacted] said Shane walked towards him and [redacted] and for a moment he [redacted] pretended they were looking for something or were leaving. He said Shane approached him and grabbed him by the wrist and told him to "walk". [redacted] said Shane told him several times to walk but he resisted, because he was scared and didn't know what was going to happen.

[redacted] said at some point he stopped resisting because Shane was stronger than him. He said Shane was dragging him down the passageway to a fence. [redacted] said he was scared because he didn't know what was about to happen to him. He said Shane then pushed him by his upper collar bone against the fence. He said the fence even wobbled but was not a very sturdy fence to begin with. [redacted] said Shane pushed him again, this time with both of his hands across his shoulders and arms. [redacted] said Shane yelled that "he loves the fuck out of [redacted] and told him to stay away.

[redacted] said he yelled help towards his friend [redacted] who was still standing by their bikes. [redacted] said Shane yelled at to stay where he was. [redacted] said Shane pushed on his head toward the fence and said something like "he would kill him, and nobody would find his body".

[redacted] said Shane also said something about a Police agency that would not find bodies, but he wasn't sure what that was about as he didn't understand it. [redacted] said at some point the entire event from when Shane dragged him across the passageway, to the fence lasted about 20 minutes. [redacted] also said it may have appeared longer to him because he was very scared. He said Shane is a Police Officer and a lot stronger than him. [redacted] said Shane told him something like "he knows everything" and told him he needed to stay away from [redacted]

[redacted] said Shane then let up from his hold. [redacted] described feeling pain when Shane was dragging him by his wrist and arm across the passageway to the fence. [redacted] said he was scared when Shane pushed him against the fence and threatened to kill him. [redacted] said [redacted] saw what Shane did but was probably too far away to hear what Shane said.

When asked how far Shane dragged him across the passageway, he estimated 20 to 30 feet before he pushed him against that residential fence. When asked what the fence looked like he said it was a regular 6 foot wooden, privacy fence. He said the fence was not sturdy and must have been lose from the last storm.

[redacted] said if [redacted] had not been there, he thought Shane would have killed him. He said when Shane walked him back to [redacted] he told them to get out of here. [redacted] said Shane yelled at [redacted] and told him that he doesn't want to see him in the neighborhood. This concluded your Affiant's observations regarding the forensic interview with [redacted]

On 03/09/2022 IS Patton and your Affiant drove to [redacted] and met with 13-year-old [redacted] in a conference room. Your Affiant observed [redacted] stated the following:

[redacted] said Shane is a Police Officer. [redacted] said he and [redacted] used to hang out at [redacted] house and Shane was [redacted] said something happened and [redacted] couldn't hang out there anymore. He said a couple of days after Valentine's Day, on or about 02/16/2022 he was hanging out riding bikes with [redacted] said they were in his neighborhood and had stopped on the sidewalk trying to figure out a "geo caching" or something like that. He said that's when Shane pulled up in a truck that was grayish or black.

[redacted] said Shane got out of the truck and walked towards them. He said Shane was wearing a uniform shirt that had a badge on. [redacted] said Shane was wearing a duty belt, like a cop. [redacted] said maybe Shane's shirt had a badge on the side by the sleeve, but he wasn't sure.

[redacted] said Shane was yelling at [redacted] to "walk" and was pointing towards the passageway before the greenbelt. [redacted] said Shane yelled "walk" a couple of times and [redacted] was trying to get his things from his bike. [redacted] said Shane then grabbed [redacted] by the arm and pulled him towards the passageway. [redacted] said [redacted] didn't want to go and was maybe resisting but Shane was stronger and kept dragging him. [redacted] said he then saw Shane pushed [redacted] against a wobbly fence. [redacted] said the fence was already wobbly, but he saw it wobble when Shane pushed [redacted] against it a couple of times.

[redacted] said he couldn't hear what Shane was saying and noted that [redacted] then came over from the mailbox because she saw Shane was there. [redacted] said [redacted] yelled at [redacted] "not to say anything" to Shane.

[redacted] said he heard [redacted] yelled "help" one time, but Shane had told him to stay put and since he was a Police Officer that's what he did.

[redacted] again said [redacted] said help and about five or ten minutes later [redacted] came over to him. [redacted] said Shane tried to cover [redacted] so [redacted] couldn't see him, but that didn't work well. [redacted] said [redacted] shouted to [redacted] not to talk to him before she walked away again.

[redacted] said Shane and [redacted] then came walking back toward him and Shane told him he [redacted] was now also involved and can't go back over to [redacted] house as well. [redacted] said he remembered Shane said if [redacted] ever goes back over to [redacted] house, he will get him arrested. [redacted] said that's when Shane walked back to his truck and [redacted] came over to him and got really angry and upset.

Your Affiant would respectfully request that probable cause be found that Shane Hugh Reed, DOB: 11/02/1991 SSN: [redacted] did, within the City of Colorado Springs, County of El Paso, State of Colorado, commit in violation of the Colorado Revised Statutes 1973 as amended, the offense(s) of §18-3-302 (1), SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING, CLASS FOUR FELONY (F4); §18-6-401 (1)(A)(7)(A), CHILD ABUSE-KNOWINGLY/RECKLESSLY ANY INJURY OTHER THAN SBI, CLASS ONE MISDEMEANOR (M1); §18-3-206, MENACING -THREAT/PHYSICAL ACTION/FEAR OF SBI, CLASS THREE MISDEMEANOR, (M3); §18-9-111 (1)(A), HARRASSMENT-STRIKE,SHOVE,KICK, CLASS THREE MISDEMEANOR (M3).
