ATTACHMENT - DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF ARREST WARRANT

INVESTIGATION DETAILS:

On 01/15/2021, I, John Candias, FBI-Task Force Officer and members of the JTTF - Riverside Field Office conducted a search warrant at Luna's residence. During an interview, Luna admitted to the aforementioned social media posts and said he is an adherent of the QAnon conspirator movement and the three-percenter (3%) militia group.

An Automated Firearms System (AFS) query identified Luna as the current recorded owner of the following firearms:

- Springfield Armory, 9mm Pistol, semi-auto, model XOS, SN: S3824682
- J.P. & Sons, 9mm Pistol, semi-auto, model P320, SN: 58A001230
- 3. Remington Arms, Cal .308 Rifle, model 700 SPS TAC, SN: RR810796
- 4. FNH, .45 Pistol, semi-auto, model FNX45, SN: FX3U007473
- Smith and Wesson, Cal .38, Revolver, model 652, SN: CPV4169
- Heckler & Koch, Cal .40 Pistol, semi-auto, model USP40, SN: 22098710
- 7. Sig .45 Pistol, semi-auto, model P220B, SN: G328988 (**note this firearm was not located at Luna's residence at this time. Numbers 1-6 were identified and seized.

During the search of Luna's residence, all of the above stated firearms (1-6) were identified, collected, and seized pursuant to the court ordered temporary Gun Violence Restraining Order - EPO. In addition, the following firearm was discovered underneath Luna's master bedroom bed: Smith and Wesson, assault rifle with EO-tech optic, TLR weapon light, model: M&P 15, SN 16842.

I asked Luna if he completed a legal transfer of any and all of his firearms and Luna stated "Yes."

I then showed Luna the Riffe found under his bed. When asked, Luna stated, "yes, that's mine." Luna said he bought the rifle from a coworker at Cathedral City Police Department a few years ago. I asked Luna if he remembered the name of the Officer that he bought the rifle from, Luna stated he did not remember his name. I asked Luna if he applied for an assault weapon registration. Luna stated he could not remember.

I queried the Automated Firearms System (AFS) system on the rifle serial number, there was no record on file. I examined the following firearm at Luna's residence: Smith and Wesson, assault rifle with Eotech optic, TLR weapon light, model: M&P 15, SN 16842 and I determined the firearm met the definition of an assault weapon pursuant to PC 30515. Below is an examination of the assault weapon.

I examined and photographed the rifle, a Smith and Wesson, AR-15 with Eotech optic, TLR weapon light, model: MP&15, SN 16842, black in color. The rifle's lower receiver was marked as a Smith and Wesson, Model M&P 15, Serial # 16842. The rifle's chamber appeared consistent in size and shape with a .223 or 5.56mm chamber, and the barrel was marked 5.56 (indicating the barrel was chambered for the 5.56mm NATO round (5.56x45mm). The rifle's barrel was rifled, and was unobstructed. The rifle's gas tube appeared to be intact, and I could see what appeared to be a complete and functional bolt assembly. I did not see any parts missing from the rifle, internally or externally. The rifle had a two-position fire selector switch, which is consistent with a semi-automatic AR-type rifle. The rifle function tested as a semi-automatic rifle. The rifle had a telescoping stock, a pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously beneath the action of the weapon, and an adjustable forward pistol grip. I found that an ammunition magazine was removable by activating the magazine release button located on the right side of the receiver with my aided finger (old bullet button). Based on the above information and my training and experience, it is my opinion that being a semi-automatic, center-fire rifle that has the capacity to accept a detachable magazine (not a fixed magazine), has a telescoping stock, a pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously beneath the action of the weapon, and an adjustable forward pistol grip the rifle seized meets the statutory definition of an assault weapon. My report was reviewed by Special Agent Manny Parra (CALDOJ), (951) 202-0524. Agent Parra advised he will complete a supplemental report for violation of CA Penal Code sections 30515(a)(1)(A), (C), and and (F), 30605(a)(1), Possession of an unregistered assault weapon.
