I, Armando Olmos, Senior Officer, at the Federal Correctional Complex, Victorville, CA, do hereby make this statement freely without any promises or assurances:

1. I understand this is an official investigation and I am required to cooperate fully by providing all pertinent information. I understand that I have a duty to reply to questions in this investigation, and the agency may take disciplinary action, including dismissal, if I refuse to answer or fail to reply fully and truthfully to each question. *AO*
2. I have not taken any medication nor have I consumed any alcoholic beverages nor any illegal drugs prior to being interviewed that would interfere with my ability to answer questions in this investigation. *AO*
3. I do not have any recording devices on my person or in my effects and I understand that this interview is not being recorded by the investigator. *AO*
4. I began my employment in the Bureau of Prisons February 3, 2008. *AO*
5. I am currently a Senior Officer here at the Federal Correctional Complex, Victorville, CA. *AO*
6. I was assigned to USP Special Housing number 4 Officer on July 29, 2015 from the hours of 6:15 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. *AO*
7. Yes, I do recall the events that took place on July 29, 2015. I observed inmate Cyrus Sullivan #74918-085 being aggressive and refusing to go back into his cell after his cell was searched. Inmate Sullivan then became combative while Officer

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Luna attempted to put him back into his cell. Inmate Sullivan turned in an aggressive manner and struck Officer Luna in the facial area. I assisted in placing Inmate Sullivan on the ground in order to gain control of his aggressive behavior. I assisted staff in controlling inmate Sullivan's I did hear a staff member say something about him coming out of restraints but I don't remember who it was. Once we get full control of Inmate Sullivan he was then escorted to the observation cell to be medically assessed. *AS*

8. At no time did I see Officer Luna twist inmate Sullivan's wrist nor did I see Officer Luna punch inmate Sullivan while he was on the ground. *AS*
9. At no time did I see Lieutenant Williams punch inmate Sullivan in the face while we were in the observation cell. *AS*
10. I never seen any other staff members twist the inmates wrist nor did I see any other staff members punch inmate Sullivan. Nor did I twist his wrist nor did I punch him. *AS*
11. I have read this affidavit thoroughly and I have been given the opportunity to make change, corrections and additions. *AS*
12. I have no further information I can provide relative to this investigation at this time. *AS*
13. I have fully cooperated with this investigation and I do not know of, or have any additional information that I have not already mentioned concerning this case. I understand I am not to discuss anything about this interview or any other information concerning this case, with anyone other than a Special Investigative Supervisor/Agent (SIS/SIA). *AS*


