CYRUS SULLIVAN TOOK FIREWORKS APART AND PUT THEM TOGETHER  
WITH OTHER FIREWORKS' PARTS INTO PLASTIC POP BOTTLES MANUFACTURING  
DESTRUCTIVE DEVICES. HE EXPLAINED TO MATTHEW GOODHART WHAT  
HE WAS DOING. SULLIVAN WAS LIGHTING THE DEVICES OFF  
ON AN OPEN DECK AND IN CLOSE PROXIMITY OF TWO PUBLIC  
SIKAWALKS, PUTTING PASSERBYS IN DANGER OF SERIOUS  
PHYSICAL INJURY.

SOURCE OF ACTIVITY: I WAS DISPATCHED TO 791 E. 15<sup>th</sup> REGARDING  
ILLEGAL FIREWORKS.

OFC. OBS. / INVEST: I ARRIVED AND CONTACTED GOODHART. HE TOLD  
ME THAT SULLIVAN HAD BEEN TAKING SMALL FIREWORKS APART AND  
POTTING THEM TOGETHER IN EMPTY POP BOTTLES, MAKING LARGER  
FIREWORKS. HE SAID SULLIVAN WAS LIGHTING THEM OFF ON THE  
OUTDOOR DECK. THE DECK IS NEXT TO THE SIDEWALK OF E. 15<sup>th</sup> AND


MANUF. DEST. DEVICE

A SHORT DISTANCE FROM THE SIDEWALK OF ALDER, BOTH OF THESE SIDEWALKS ARE VERY BUSY WITH PEDESTRIANS, EVEN AT THIS TIME OF YEAR. OFC. GLEMSER AND I FOUND NUMEROUS PLASTIC POP BOTTLES THAT APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN BLOWN UP, AND POP BOTTLE CARS WITH WHEELS IN THEM. THE BOTTLES AND CARS WERE ON THE DECK AND ALL AROUND THE DECK NEXT TO THE SIDEWALKS.

WITH THE DEBRIS SPREAD OUT AND THAT CLOSE TO THE SIDEWALKS, A PASSING PEDESTRIAN COULD BE LIKELY TO RECEIVE A SERIOUS PHYSICAL INJURY FROM EXPLODING PIECES. SEE OFC. GLEMSER'S REPORT FOR DETAILS.

GOODHART TOLD ME THAT LAST NIGHT HE HEARD, WHAT SOUNDED LIKE GUN SHOT COME FROM THE DECK. IT'S ON THE SAME LEVEL AS HIS APARTMENT. HE WENT OUT TO THE DECK AND FOUND SULLIVAN AND "BEN" ON THE DECK AND LAUGHING. GOODHART TOLD ME THAT SULLIVAN SAID HE WAS MAKING A DEVICE OR LARGER FIRECRACKERS USING SMALLER FIREWORKS THAT HE BOUGHT IN SPRINGFIELD. HE SAID SULLIVAN EXPLAINED HE WAS TAKING SMALLER ONES (FIREWORKS) APART AND PUTTING THEM INTO POP BOTTLES. HE HEARD A COUPLE MORE EXPLOSIONS AFTER THAT.

GOODHART SAID HE HEARD MORE EXPLOSIONS TODAY AND HAD A RESIDENT FROM ROOM #20 COMPLAINING ABOUT THE EXPLOSIONS. THE RESIDENT IN #20 WAS GAVIN HAWORTH AND WAS NOT HOME FOR


OFC. GLEMSEY GATHERED AND LOGGED THE EXPLODED BOTTLES.

GOODHART WALKED US UP TO SULLIVAN'S APARTMENT. HE GAVE ME A PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION FIRST.

STANDING OUTSIDE OF SULLIVAN'S APARTMENT, I COULD SEE INTO HIS APARTMENT BECAUSE IT WAS OPEN A FEW INCHES. I SAW SULLIVAN CROUCHING DOWN ON THE FLOOR DOING SOMETHING WITH HIS HANDS. A VERY STRONG ODOR OF MARIJUANA WAS FLOWING OUT THROUGH THAT OPEN GAP. OFC. GLEMSEY WAS STANDING BEHIND ME. I HEARD HIM REACT TO THE ODOR OF MARIJUANA WITH A, "WOW!" I SAW MARIJUANA PIPES AND OTHER PARAPHERNALIA IN PLAIN VIEW. I ALSO SAW PLASTIC POP BOTTLES THAT WERE CONSISTENT WITH THE EXPLODED ONES FROM OUTSIDE.

ARREST / CUSTODY: I KNOCKED AND SULLIVAN CAME TO THE DOOR. I ASKED IF WE COULD TALK IN HIS ROOM. HE SAID, "NO." AND OFC. GLEMSEY AND I ARRESTED HIM AND PUT HIM INTO HANDCUFFS. OFC. GLEMSEY ADVISED SULLIVAN HIS RIGHTS VIA THE MIRANDA WARNING AT ABOUT 2235 HOURS. HE SAID, "YES" TO UNDERSTANDING. HE ADVISED HE WOULDN'T ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS WITHOUT HIS ATTORNEY AND THAT HE WAS EXERCISING HIS RIGHTS. NO QUESTIONS WERE ASKED. OFC. GLEMSEY SEIZED AND LOGGED TORN UP FIREWORKS AND OTHER DEVICE MAKING PARAPHERNALIA. OFC. STINGS TOOK PHOTOS.
