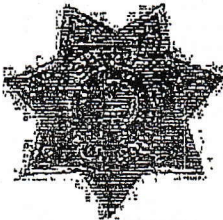
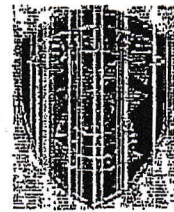

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION BY DEPUTY GORE

On April 18th, 2005 Sgt. Downing and I went to Portland and contacted Sullivan at his dorm room at Portland State University. We were accompanied by Portland State University Public Safety. After knocking on the door several a male subject opened the door. I introduced myself and asked if he was Cyrus Sullivan, he asked me what was going on. I then asked him again if he was Cyrus Sullivan. Again he paused and seemed to be nervous. He then confirmed he was Cyrus Sullivan. He told him why I was there talking with him and he denied sending anything to the TKE house. [REDACTED]

I changed the conversation back to why we were there to begin with. I asked Sullivan if he uses the computer name [REDACTED] he paused and said no. I told him that I did not believe him and I asked him if was assigned scroll number T891 when he joined TKE, he said yes. I then explained to him the letters that were sent had the name [REDACTED] T891 signed to them. He told me anyone could have used that name. I told him yes but he was the only member with a vendetta against the TKE's at this time. I then told him what the charges were going to be.

I then explained to Sullivan that if cooperated and told me the truth I could issued him a citation in lieu of custody or if wanted to continue to lie I could arrest him and take him to the Benton County Correctional Facility. He then asked if he could see the citation, I showed the citation that I had already prepared. Sullivan then said "I think I should talk to my attorney." I told him he was under arrest and had him turn around and place his hands behind his back, which he did. I handcuffed him behind the back and checked for tightness. I then double locked and he asked if he could put his pants on. Sgt. Downing said he yes, Sullivan turned around and we all walked into his room. Sullivan led us back to the living room area where I saw a Dell Computer on desk. Laying next to the computer were white pieces of paper with print on them. The print contained the word [REDACTED] on them. I did not read the content. Sullivan confirmed he was the only person that lived in the room. Given the fact that the documents that were sent out were made from a computer I had probable cause to believe the computer Sullivan used was the one on the desk in his room. I seized the computer hard driver along with a photo which contained photos of the TKE members from the Corvallis chapter. These items were seized and put into evidence. I will write an affidavit in support of a search warrant later and request the court to issue a warrant.

We transported Sullivan to the B.C.C.F. where he was booked and released. I issued him a receipt for the items seized.

The TKE's received a letter from [REDACTED] T891 shortly after receiving the Sex Offender Notification letters. The contents of this letter was that the TKE house would be hosting a free STD clinic. The letter contained four testimonials with the pictures and names of four TKE members. The four pictures on the letter are also on the photo seized from Sullivan's room. There is also hand written notes on the letter. [REDACTED]

FORGERY/FRAUD

On April 4th, 2005 [redacted] came to office report a friend complaint. He first spoke with Lt. Ridler and it was then assigned to me to investigate. I made arrangements to meet with [redacted] at my office, on April 13th, 2005 at 9:00 am.

[redacted] is currently attending OSU and belongs to the Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE) Fraternity. This is where [redacted] met former TKE member Cyrus Sullivan. During [redacted] was the house manager and was responsible for assuring certain duties and functions were done around the house. This would sometimes cause frictions with some of the house members. Sullivan left the fraternity only after 3 terms. According to [redacted] Sullivan was going to be kicked out anyway. [redacted] and Sullivan had a mutual friend that they would both instant message (IM) from time to time. This is what started a verbal exchange between Sullivan and [redacted]. Although, nothing physically happened unpleasant words would be exchanged via IM. When a person is using IM they are assigned a user name. [redacted] was assigned [redacted] and Sullivan was assigned [redacted].

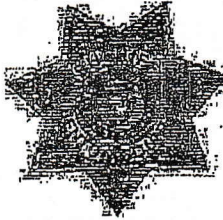
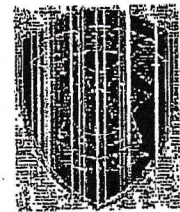
This then prompted Sullivan to create and send via mail and electronically a Criminal Sex Offender Release Notification. This contained [redacted] personal information as well as his picture. The picture that was used was his fraternity picture. Each year the fraternity takes a group photo as well as individual photos. Each member is then given a copy of the photo. [redacted] thinks Sullivan used this photo in creating the document by scanning it into his (Sullivan) computer and then adjusting the photo to fit on the document.

[redacted] first learned of this from his roommate and fellow TKE member. He had received it the mail. [redacted] then went to the frat house and discovered it had been sent there as well. [redacted] then contacted our office. After leaving our office that day he went home and checked his mail. He had then received his copy of the notification. His contained a hand written note on the back stating: copies of this document have been sent to every TKE member as well as the sororities around OSU. It's signed [redacted] T891. The T891 represents a number used by the TKE's when a member signs the scroll he is issued a corresponding number. When Sullivan signed the scroll he was issued number T891.

[redacted] is upset with what Sullivan had done and wants to pursue this matter to ensure this does not happen to anyone else. [redacted] provided me with the notifications as well as a printed copy of the IM exchange between him and Sullivan. In this exchange Sullivan admits to creating the document and sending it via the mail. Sullivan also admits to making other notifications but he did not send them out because the postage was too much. However, he (Sullivan) did send them to [redacted] via the computer and [redacted] was able to print them out so he could give them to me. I asked [redacted] if he could down load all the files onto a CD and give it to me, he said he would. I placed the seized items into evidence.

Sgt. Downing and I will attempt to contact Sullivan in Portland early next week.

On March 4th, 2005 I was assigned to investigate this complaint. [REDACTED] had contacted our office because a former fraternity brother, Cyrus Sullivan, had forged a Criminal Sex Offender Release Notification with [REDACTED] name and personal information on it. Both were members of the Tau Kappa Epsilon (TKE). Mr. Sullivan sent this document to the TKE house and its members. He also sent it to the local sororities as well. Mr. Sullivan admitted to doing this to [REDACTED] via instant messaging. Mr. Sullivan is currently on probation with Multnomah County Community Corrections and living in the Portland area. I will attempt to contact Mr. Sullivan next week.
