




Inside the letter were three pages listing title, hashtags, category, sub category, Location, Location status, and body. These pages are lined out exactly like the web site, https://copblaster.com/ that inmate Sullivan has been posting information about Law Enforcement, and other government officials to. Inmate Sullivan is sending this to _____ with the intent of it being uploaded to the web site by a third party. On July 18, 2018 a copy of the court order was received and it states "Defendant shall have no direct or indirect access to copblasters.com or any similar web site." Inmate Sullivan is listed as the defendant on the court order.</p> | | | |

11. Description Of Incident (Date: 01/11/18 _____ Time: 11:30 am _____ Staff become aware of incident)

On 1/11/2018, the SIS office received a cop-out from inmate Cyrus Sullivan #74918-065 addressed to D. Prock (writer). In the cop-out, he threatens to place my information on the internet because I wrote him an incident report. The cop-out reads in part, "I have been given evidence twice this week that you have diverted mail to yourself from its intended destinations. Mail theft will not be tolerated..." Inmate Sullivan closes the copout with "Https://Copblaster.com/hashtag/theft and https://copblaster.com/hashtag/spying, Spying will not be tolerated either. It is creepy, so mind your own business." The two web addresses are a web site that inmate Sullivan uses to post Law Enforcement officers personal information. This is an attempt by inmate Sullivan to bully and intimidate staff.


