SUBJECT: Status of Lock-Down

The purpose of this memorandum is to update each of you on the status of the Lock-Down. The USP is currently locked down, not only due to the two incidents today, but from the multiple incidents that have occurred over the past few weeks involving serious injuries. This type of behavior disrupts the orderly running of the institution and will not be tolerated. Recent behavior and prohibited acts have seriously jeopardized the safety and security of USP Victorville.

On March 7, 2016, USP Victorville will conduct showers for all inmates housed in the general population. All inmates will be escorted restrained prior to departing their assigned cell.

All meals will be provided and consumed in their assigned cells. Immediately following the meal, all waste will be collected. No fruit will remain in cells. It will be consumed with the meal or disposed of during waste pick-up.

No visitation is scheduled for this weekend and all televisions will remain off.
