with the condition of a thirty-six (36) month probationary period to begin on the date of this Order. This Order shall serve as a reprimand to Respondent.

2.

During **the** period of probation, Respondent shall not violate any law of this State or of **the** United **States**, or any rule or policy of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council.

3.

Respondent acknowledges that **he** has read this Consent Order, and understands **the** terms and conditions described herein.

Respondent further understands **that he** has the right to a hearing in this matter, and waives such right by freely, voluntarily, and knowingly entering into this Consent

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Order.

4.

As evidenced by his signature affixed below, Respondent
agrees to abide by all laws of the State of Georgia, the rules
and regulations of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and
Training Council, and the provisions of this Consent
Order.

Upon noncompliance with the terms and conditions of **this** Consent
Order, the approval of Respondent's application may be
vacated,
and his application denied or certification revoked if already

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certified, in accordance with the Georgia Administrative
Procedure Act.
