Request for Administrative Remedy Case No.: 846516-F3

This is in response to your Request for Administrative Remedy received in this office on January 13, 2016, in which you challenge the number of points you were given under the History of Violence category on your Custody Classification Form. As relief, you request your History of Violence points be reduced from seven points to five points.

Research into this matter showed in 2013, you made threatening comments to a judge and a victim of your crime. On March 11, 2015, you were found guilty of violating Code 224, Assaulting Without Serious Injury. Specifically, you slapped a female staff member at the halfway house and you were placed under arrest. On August 12, 2015, you were again found guilty of violating Code 224, Assaulting Without Serious Injury, when you struck an officer in the chest with your elbow. Furthermore on September 9, 2015, you were found guilty of violating Code 224, Assaulting Without Serious Injury, when you struck an officer with your elbow. You are currently scored at seven points (< Five Years Serious), under the History of Violence Category on your Custody Classification Form. All of these incidents occurred within the last five years. Therefore, you are scored appropriately and in accordance with Program Statement 5100.08, Inmate Security Designation and Custody Classification.

Accordingly, your Request for Administrative Remedy is denied. If you are not satisfied with this response, you may appeal to the Western Regional Director. Your appeal must be received by the Regional Administrative Remedy Coordinator, Federal Bureau of Prisons, Western Regional Office, 7338 Shoreline Drive, Stockton, CA 95219, within twenty (20) calendar days from the date of this response.
