JURY SUMMONS

BY ORDER OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE

GREETINGS:

You are hereby summoned to serve as a juror in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Multnomah County beginning on the date below. **Your term of service includes the date below and the following day, and it continues until the completion of any trial(s) for which you were selected.** Some trials are short so you may serve on more than one jury. Other trials are longer so your service may continue beyond **two days**.

Your service begins on: **WEDNESDAY, JULY 22, 2020**

Also, seven to fourteen jurors may be selected to serve on the Grand Jury, for which the term of service is one month. If you are not selected to serve on the Grand Jury, and you are not selected to serve on a trial jury your service will conclude at the end of the two day period.

Reporting Time and Place: You are to report to the **Jury Assembly Room - 130** at Multnomah County Courthouse, 1021 SW Fourth Avenue (between Main and Salmon) Portland, Oregon on the above date. The Courthouse opens at 7:00 AM. The **Jury Assembly Room - 130** will open at 7:30 AM. You must report no later than 8:00 AM. You will receive further instructions on jury service at that time.

Please complete and sign the enclosed eligibility response post card and mail it as soon as possible (postage is pre-paid). The returned post card is essential for the Court to verify your eligibility to serve and to complete your juror record.

Responsibility to Respond to this Summons: Each eligible person has an obligation to serve as a juror to protect the right of every person to a trial by jury. The right to a trial by jury has meaning only if you and others serve as jurors. Under law, a person is required to respond to this Circuit Court summons by completing the eligibility response post card, and if eligible, by serving as summoned, deferring service to a future date, or being excused. If you do not respond to the summons, you may be ordered by the Court to complete and return the eligibility response post card or to appear before the Court and show cause why you should not be held in contempt. If you are ordered to show cause you risk arrest if you do not appear. If you are charged with contempt, you risk criminal sanctions if found in contempt. Please support the right to a trial by jury and respond to this summons.
