I spoke with [REDACTED] by telephone on August 18, 2017. I introduced myself as a defense investigator representing Cyrus Sullivan and [REDACTED] agreed to speak with me.

[REDACTED] said that he was in the pill line on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and Cyrus Sullivan (whose name he could not recall) was standing next to him in the pill line. [REDACTED] had some Gatorade and he offered it to Cyrus. [REDACTED] said that there is a rule about Gatorade being reserved for inmates who are having withdrawal symptoms from drug use but much of the time the medical staff ignores this rule.

Cyrus accepted the offer, but as soon as he had the cup of Gatorade in his hand the medical technician dispensing pills told Cyrus he couldn't drink it. The deputy supervising the pill line also told Cyrus he couldn't drink it. Cyrus drank the Gatorade anyway and the deputy told him that he was going into the hole.

Cyrus ran up the stairs to his cell. He did not yell any threats except to say, "You want me to put your name on my website?!!" He said this to the medical technician.

After Cyrus ran to his cell three to five deputies arrived and entered Cyrus's cell. [REDACTED] did not observe anything else relevant.
